NAPA Study - Published in 1998

Geographic Information for the 21st Century

- Proposed by American Congress on Surveying & Mapping.
- Conducted by the prestigious National Academy of Public Administration (NAPA 1998).
- Spurned by some bureaucrats and federal agencies.
- Supported before Congress by Secretary Babbitt (June '99).
- Calls for creation of:
 - 1. National Spatial Data Council (NSDC) located in private sector.
 - 2. Geographic Data Service alternate is U.S.G.S.
- Builds on the National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) as defined and developed by the Federal Geographic Data Committee (FGDC).

The Global Spatial Data Model (GSDM)

- Provides a simple, universal 3-dimensional mathematical foundation for the NSDI.
- Describes an efficient manner for organizing 3-dimensional spatial data on a global scale using local relationships.
- Defines computational procedures for manipulating spatial data.
 One set of equations is equally applicable world-wide.
- Gives mathematical definitions for spatial data accuracy.
